The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, May 24, 2021, with the roll being called, the following Supervisors were present and absent: Chairman Matt Greiner, present; Member Alan Yahnke, present; Member Ron Bride, absent.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

The Board met with custodian Randy Norman, and discussion was held regarding general courthouse maintenance.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported that the county crews were blading, hauling rock, ditching and mowing. They have also done some patching on Lilac Ave., and more repairs will be done as weather allows. The contract approved earlier, with Norris Asphalt, was signed for the multiple road paving project.

Matt Greiner made motion, seconded by Alan Yahnke and carried unanimously, to approve a temporary road closure, for the Floris Flag Day celebration on Saturday, June 5, 2021, and to provide signage, for said temporary closure.

The Board met with Heidi Kuhl, from Northland Securities regarding details for financing the multiple road paving project, and the agreement for purchasing the General Obligation Bonds.

Alan Yahnke made motion, seconded by Matt Greiner and carried unanimously, to approve the following resolution:

Resolution approving Bond Purchase Agreement for General Obligation County Road Improvements Bonds, Series 2021A

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") of Davis County, Iowa (the "County"), has proposed to enter into a general obligation loan agreement (the "Loan Agreement"), pursuant to the provisions of Section 331.402 of the Code of Iowa, for the purpose of paying the cost of construction of improvements to certain county roads, and has published notice and held a hearing on the proposal; and

WHEREAS, it has been proposed that the County enter into the Loan Agreement with Northland Securities, Inc., Minneapolis, MN (the "Underwriter") and issue General Obligation County Road Improvements Bonds, Series 2021A (the "Bonds") in evidence of its obligations under the Loan Agreement; and

WHEREAS, a certain Bond Purchase Agreement (the "Bond Purchase Agreement") has been prepared setting forth the terms of the Bonds and the understanding between the County and the Underwriter, and it is now necessary to make provision for the approval of the Bond Purchase Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Davis County, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. The Bond Purchase Agreement is hereby approved in substantially the form as presented to this Board. The Chairperson and County Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Bond Purchase Agreement to the Underwriter.

Section 2. All resolutions and orders or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this resolution, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.
