The Davis County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, January 27, 2025 with Chairman Alan Yahnke and Members Ron Bride and David Henderson present.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve the agenda.

David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously, to approve and sign the Minutes of Monday, January 20, 2025. Alan Yahnke abstained as he was absent from the Monday, January 20, 2025 meeting.

The Board met with Engineer Ryan Schock, who reported on the blading, snow removal and equipment repair work being done by the County crews. Engineer Schock also discussed with the Board drafting a letter of guidelines for other County organizations that use Secondary Roads' equipment.

The Board signed applications for SIDCA (Southern Iowa Development Conservation Authority) projects, one for the 150th Street bridge project and one for the box culvert on Fir Avenue.

The Board met with Sheriff Zach Dunlavy who reported there are currently 10 inmates in the jail. He also reported on issues with the furnace at the Law Center and that he is working on getting some of the Sheriff's Department property returned from former employees.

The Board met with Jen Cutler, Bloomfield Mainstreet Director, who requested the use of the Davis County courtyard for several events planned for 2025. David Henderson made motion, seconded by Ron Bride and carried unanimously to approve this request.

The Board met with Roger Wuthrich, Amy Tyson and Marilyn Piper, members of the Bloomfield Public Library Board, regarding the upcoming fiscal year 2026 budget. No action was taken.
